Our Ministry

Crossroads Preschool is a Christian early childhood education ministry of Crossroads Church. The preschool is based on a child-centered, Christian foundation. Learning experiences will encourage and challenge the children to participate, explore, imagine and express themselves as they develop *kindergarten readiness - curiosity, eagerness and an understanding that learning is fun!*

With God as our authority, we are committed to glorifying Him through every aspect of our ministry in partnering with families as we help their children grow to be all that He created them to be.

Commitment to Excellence

The preschool will encourage and guide children in seven (7) areas of development:

- ♥ cognitive
- ♥ creative
- ♥ emotional
- ♥ language
- ♥ physical
- ♥ social
- ♥ spiritual
- ♥ Our well-rounded ministry (with experiences in all of the above areas of development) lays a strong foundation for a child to reach his/her fullest potential for future learning and helps to shape success later in school and into adulthood.
- ♥ All staff have child abuse and criminal record clearances and background checks.
- ♥ Our objectives are established and written in compatibility with the area school district and with the PA Department of Education Core Standards in order to ensure that Crossroads Preschool properly prepares each child for kindergarten.

2 Year Old Classes

- Child must be 2 years old on or before 8/31/21. Classes meet September to May:
Friday 9-11 am
Friday 12-2 pm
- Class size is maximum of 8 children.
- Classroom staff includes 1 teacher and 1 teacher's assistant.
- A \$30.00 NON-REFUNDABLE registration fee per class is required for each child.
- There is a one-time \$25.00 annual supply fee per child.
- Tuition is \$65.00 per month due monthly 8/10/21 thru 4/10/22.

3 Year Old Classes

- Child must be 3 years old on or before 8/31/21.
- Must be toilet trained.
- Classes meet from September to May:
M/W 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
M/W 12:15 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.
Tu/Th from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
Tu/Th from 12:15 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.
- Class size: maximum 15 children.
- Classroom staff includes 1 teacher and 1 teacher's assistant.
- A \$30.00 NON-REFUNDABLE registration fee per class is required for each child.
- There is a one-time \$25.00 annual supply fee per child.
- Tuition is \$105.00 per month due monthly 8/10/21 thru 4/10/22.

4 Year Old Classes

- Child must be four years old on or before 8/31/21.
- Must be toilet trained.
- Classes meet from September to May:
M/W/F from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
M/W/F 12:15 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.
/Th from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Tu/Th from 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Class size: maximum 18 children.
- Classroom staff includes 1 teacher and 1 teacher's assistant.
- A \$30.00 NON-REFUNDABLE registration fee per class is required for each child.
- There is a one-time \$25.00 annual supply fee per child.
- Tuition is:
\$115.00 per month for the M/W/F classes due monthly 8/10/21 thru 4/10/22.
\$110.00 per month for the Tu/Th classes due monthly 8/10/21 thru 4/10/22.

Bridge Class – 5 Year Old Class

- This class is designed specifically for children who are old enough for kindergarten but “just not quite ready” for the rigorous demands of today's kindergarten so we can help set them up for success. This class is to help the children strengthen their skills socially, emotionally, academically and so much more. Child must be five years old on or before 8/31/21.
- Must be toilet trained.
- Classes meet from September to May: M-Th from 9 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Class size: maximum 18 children.
- Classroom staff includes 1 teacher and 1 teacher's assistant.
- A \$30.00 NON-REFUNDABLE registration fee per class is required for each child.
- There is a one-time \$25.00 annual supply fee per child.
- Tuition is \$200.00 per month for the M/TuW/Th classes due monthly 8/10/21 thru 4/10/22.

What the Bridge class is not...this is not a Special Education class staffed by Special Ed teachers. We do not have the support, modifications, and accommodations to meet the needs of such children and cannot meet their needs in the way in which they deserve.

Our History

Crossroads Church

Today, nearly 3,000 people call Crossroads Church their home church. Crossroads Church has 5 regions with p worship services each weekend as well as church online at <https://xr.church/watch>. Crossroads has missions and church planting work in the U.S., Mozambique and France. In the summer of 1991, Rev. Steve Cordle was appointed by Bishop George Bashore to establish a new United Methodist Church in the area near the Pittsburgh International Airport. Crossroads held its first worship service at the Tonidale Restaurant on September 29, 1991. We opened the doors to our current facility in Pittsburgh West on November 5, 1995. Quickly outgrowing space, the Family Life Center was added to the facility and opened its doors in June 2002, expanding with much needed space for children & youth ministries. Once again outgrowing space, Crossroads Church expanded to a 2nd region location in Bridgeville, PA in October 2005 (now relocated to Upper St. Clair), a 3rd region in July 2007 in Pittsburgh's East Liberty community, and a 4th region in the summer of 2010 in Cranberry Twp., PA. The fall of 2012 saw another expansion at the Pittsburgh West region location. A new 600-seat worship area and children's wing opened, offering the much needed space for our expanding ministries. In addition, the new children's wing offered increased security for the safety of the children. October 2014 ushered in the opening of our 5th region, in Weirton, WV.

Crossroads Preschool

2021-2022 will be the 26th year of Crossroads Preschool at the Pittsburgh West Region, having opened its doors to the first classes of children in the fall of 1996. As the preschool needs of this rapidly growing community became greater, it was evident that Crossroads Church could help meet these needs by launching its own early childhood education ministry for children in the community. It was through our love and commitment to children that the ministry was established to provide children with a strong and positive foundation through the love of Jesus Christ. Crossroads Preschool has grown from two classes in 1996 to eleven classes today.
