**Where in the world are we going this year?** Our neighbors in need are found approximately 3 hours to the south of Pittsburgh

**How will we get there?** We will be carpooling and will depart from the Pittsburgh West campus Saturday morning, October 23rd at 10:00 am (formerly North Fayette)

**What will it cost?** This year's cost is \$400 which covers t-shirt, gasoline, food and some supplies for the week

**Where will we sleep?** The WV Ministry of Advocacy & Workcamps, Inc. will house us at the Summerville Presbyterian Church which has space for cots and air mattresses. They have three showers and a fully equipped kitchen.

**How will we feed ourselves?** Just like church camp, we will dine together and share in opportunities to help in the kitchen before and after breakfast and dinner. We will provide supplies to pack a lunch to eat at the work site.

**What are the tool arrangements?** This location does not provide tools, we will bring tools but if you have a saw and extension cord please let Jeff know and we may have you bring it along.

**What if I am unskilled at using tools?** Speaking from personal experience, the team will be teaching construction skills including how to use tools and everyone will be put to work!
