In this series, kids will learn from the letter that Paul wrote to the Roman church. Paul writes a load of stuff in this letter, but for this series, we are going to focus in on the way that the Holy Spirit is at work in Christ-followers. Kids will learn how these things written almost 2000 years ago by the apostle Paul are still important for us in our lives today.

WEEK	BIG IDEA	GOD STORY	THINGS TO NOTE
Week One	The Holy Spirit is active in all Christ-followers.	The Holy Spirit in You Romans 8:1-17	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will discuss and learn about the member of the Trinity known as the Holy Spirit. Kids will discover what it means that the Holy Spirit is active in the life of the Christ-follower.
Week Two	Nothing can separate us from God's love.	God's Love Romans 8:31-39	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will learn and/or be reminded of the limitless nature of God's love for us. Kids will be able to consider what this never-ending love means to them in their own lives.
Week Three	God wants to transform the way we think.	Sacrifice Romans 12:1-8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will be challenged with the idea that God wants to transform even the way we think. Kids will discover that our thinking apart from God is often not the best, most whole version of what our thoughts can be.
Week Four	Jesus shows us how to love others even when it's hard.	Action Romans 12:9-21	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will grapple with the idea that Jesus wants us to love others even when it is hard. Kids will discuss the idea that it is easy to love others when they love back, but it is much more difficult (and requires God's help!) to love others when they don't make it easy.
Week Five	Love your neighbour as you love yourself.	Love Romans 13:8-10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will learn what it looks like to love your neighbour
