Week One	How do we pray?	Jesus Teaches His Disciples to Pray Matthew 6:5-14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will learn that asking questions is not only a very good thing, but a great trait of being a disciple. Questions lead to answers. Questions allow us to learn and acquire wisdom.
Week Two	Are all religions true?	Paul Preaches in Athens Acts 17:16-34	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will learn that Jesus isn't just "a way" but "the Way" to God. That Christianity is the only understanding of God's relationship with the world where God comes to us, instead of us trying to get to God.
Week Three	What happens when we die?	The Father's House John 14:1-14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will learn that there is definitely a lot of stuff that only God knows, and that this mystery for us can be beautiful and interesting.
Week Four	Why are there so many different kinds of churches?	Jesus' Prayer for Unity John 17	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kids will learn that Jesus desire for us as Christ-followers is unity, but unity doesn't mean that we are all exactly the same. There can be unity in diversity and variety of how we follow Jesus. The important part is being united as brothers and sisters in Christ.
