SERIES OVERVIEW

In this series, children will learn from the life of the Apostle Paul. Children will discover the importance of encouraging one another in Christ. Children will learn that they can be encouraged, and they can be encouragers.

1 | Sing

2 | Read

INSTRUCTIONS

Read about how Paul listens to Jesus from Acts 26 & 27 in a children's Bible.

3 | Play

INSTRUCTIONS

Spend some time looking closely at plants with your child. Notice the colour, texture, and smell. Ask: What are the things that make a plant grow? (Rain, sun, soil) Emphasize that encouragement [kind words] helps US to grow. Encourage your child by letting them know one specific thing they do that you are proud of.

4 | Repeat

INSTRUCTIONS

For the younger children in particular, repetition is key. Repeat the Key Verse throughout your day and make it an exciting thing when your little one repeats or tries to say it along with you!
