This is a simple tool to use with Life Groups that are established, in order to help leaders honestly review their areas of strength and of weakness.

For each sentence, give your group a score from 0-10 in response to what extent you agree with that statement. This is not compared to other groups, but a relative comparison of how your community is doing in different areas of life. Answer from the perspective of the group as a whole (i.e. it's not your personal responses). Don't agonize over each question - go for your intuitive gut response!
