Creation to Joseph Genesis 1-36	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kids will discover that God's story is one that has been unfolding since the beginning of time. Joseph is a character in that story, and each kid is also a character in God's great story.</li> <li>• Kids will learn that God's heart is for them to choose to be a part of his story.</li> </ul>
<b>Week Two</b>	When God gives us a dream, he will see it through.	The Dreamer Genesis 37:1-11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kids will discover that sometimes God gives us dreams for our lives that seem bigger than ourselves. The great thing is that we may have to work to partner with God, we don't have to strive to make it happen, God will work with us to make it happen.</li> <li>• Kids will learn that we can trust God.</li> </ul>
<b>Week Three</b>	Even when things don't look good, God is with us.	Enslaved Genesis 37:12-36	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kids will learn that no matter where they go, God is always with them. There is no where they can go that is apart from God's love.</li> </ul>
