

# **Week 5 November 19**

## **Celebration Sunday**

**Main Idea: Celebrate the kids' generosity! This lesson is filled with games and a short video.**

As kids come in, welcome them and ask them how their week went. Get started by checking in on their Challenge Journals!

### **Welcome Question**

**What was it like when you gave your favorite toy?**

Take as much time as you need for this.

**I am so impressed with all of you putting God first and bringing in your favorite toy to donate! These kids are going to be so blessed by your generosity!**

### **Starting Activity**

Telephone - Split the group into two even teams. They should all be standing in two separate lines. Whisper to the kids on the same end of the line a phrase (I can bless others, I can have faith, I can trust God, I am a blessing). They must then whisper it to the next person in line, and this continues until it gets all the way down to the last person in the line. Once both lines have finished, bring the last two people up and have them say what they heard out loud to everyone. It hilariously, usually ends up being drastically different.

# Activities

## Activity 1: Bless you, Bless you, Amen

**Materials:** None

**You have blessed so many kids with your toys! Let's play a game where we bless others!**

AKA Duck, Duck, Goose! Have the kids play the well-known game Duck, Duck, Goose, but instead call it Bless You, Bless You, Amen! All the kids sit in a circle and one kid is the “blesser”. The blesser walks around the circle tapping the other kids' heads, each time the kid taps someone's head they say “Bless You” until they randomly tap a kid who they decide they would like to trade places with! When they tap the person they want they say “Amen” and run around the circle. The kid who was tapped must get up and chase the blesser. If they catch the blesser, then the blesser stays in and they keep their spot in the circle, if not, the blesser then gets to take that person's spot.

## Activity 2: I am a Blessing (20 minutes)

**Materials:** I am a Blessing Printable (1 per kid), coloring utensils

Have the kids decorate a self portrait of themselves to remind them that they can be a blessing to others when they are generous!

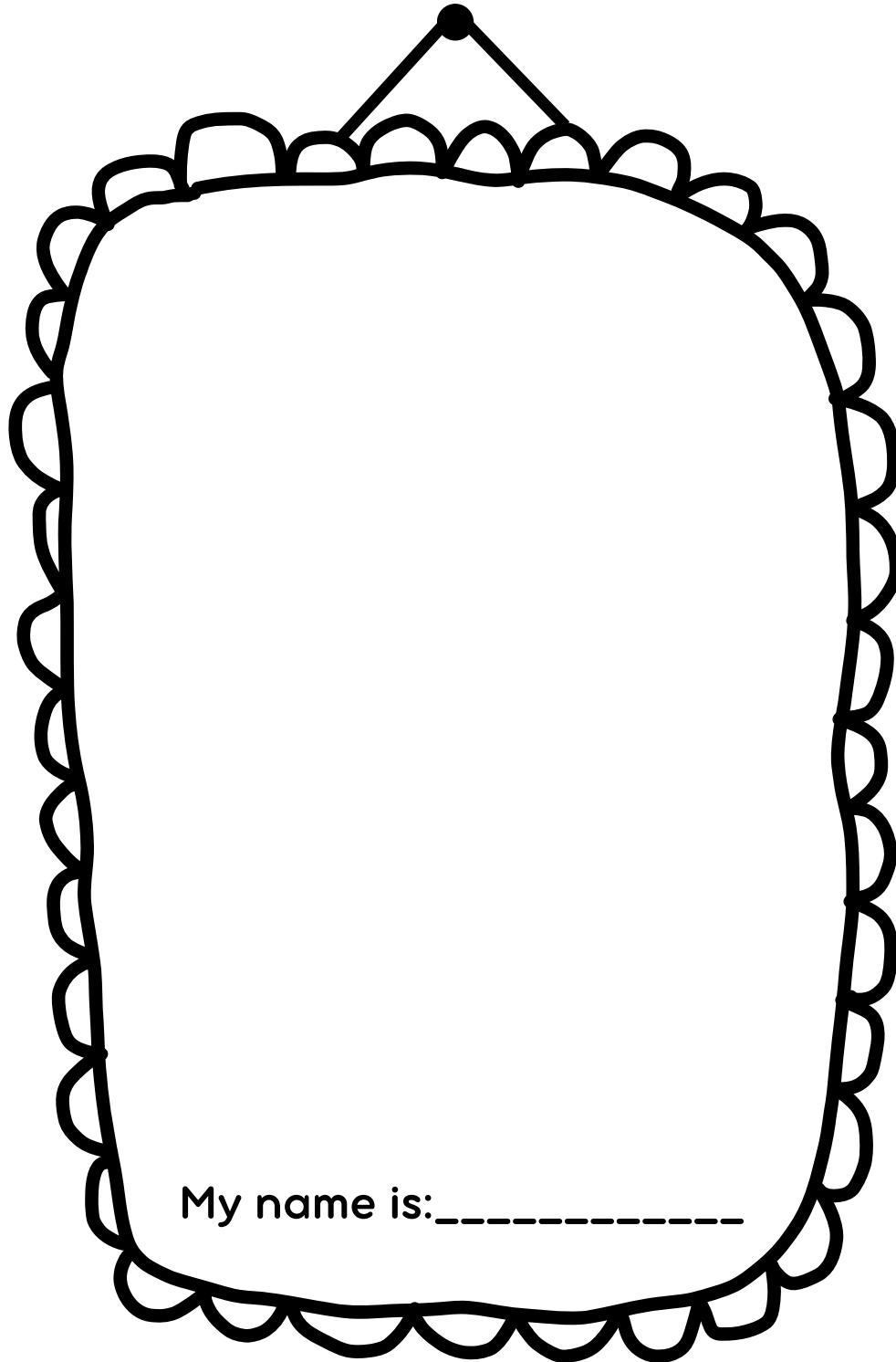
## Activity 3: Four Corners
