ADDENDUM TO SATURDAY AM BREAKOUT SESSION WITH GINA

There were about 10 minutes on Saturday morning for the first Main Session video with Gina that got cut off due to technical difficulties. The content is listed below for you to understand the context of what was happening to the point leading up to the video.

OVERVIEW/SUMMARY

Build a prayer map (places and people).

Briefly read Luke 10 to revisit Jesus sending His disciples (clip we watched last night).

Jesus sent them actively looking...

As we're building a missional lifestyle, first we have to remember it's our everyday lives where we already live/work/play that are the spaces we get to join Jesus in what he's already doing. Next, we look for people in those spaces who are open to us and might be open to Jesus (PoP - person of peace).

To think about this, we're going to **build a prayer map** so you can pray over your spaces and people every single day - that the Kingdom of God would break in and these people would give their lives to follow Jesus.

TOOL: PRAYER MAP

Places: What spaces do YOU already go where there are people who are not following Jesus yet? These are spaces where, if you were intentional, could be spaces you could look for PoP. (Neighborhood, gym, park, your kids sports/school, coffee shop, restaurant where you're a regular, library, your work, etc)

People: Next, add names of people you have met in each space who are not yet following Jesus, but they seem open to you.

Put a star next to any names that seem particularly open to you, or have already revealed they are curious about Jesus.

Give 5 min to complete personal prayer map in notes.

Take 10 min to share your prayer maps with your table.

How is God getting your attention?

Is your life built around Christians and you need to put yourself in new spaces where people who don't know Jesus hang out?

Is there one particular place it seems you have favor?

Is there one particular relationship that stands out as someone who seems really open to you?

What if you prayed for these names every single day? What might God do?

Once you find them, what do you do with them?

What do spiritual conversations sound like?

Asking curious questions is a great missional skill to learn! (Casual to meaningful to spiritual)
