Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- Where is your favorite place to walk, hike, or ride your bike?

- What's one thing you need God's help and wisdom with this week?



Give Me Five

Gather around and read the Word of Wonder—Proverbs 4:4b–5—as a family. Look for some paper at home and use it to trace your hands. Cut out the handprints.

On the palm of your handprint write: With the Holy Spirit's help, I will seek to ...

Now, for each finger on your handprint, copy each of the phrases or draw pictures that represent each one: 1) Take hold of God's words. 2) Keep God's commands. 3) Ask God for wisdom. 4) Ask God for understanding. 5) Remember God's words. After everyone is finished writing or drawing, color and decorate your handprints as you like!

Once decorating is done, find a special spot to display your handprints where they'll remind you of God's truth throughout the week.



Get ready for an exciting family adventure using just an egg, a glass of water, and some salt! Find a glass large enough to hold the egg, and fill it halfway with water. Gently drop the egg in, and watch it sink.

While the egg sinks, explain that we all have moments when we're overwhelmed and confused, sad or scared, and it feels like we're sinking. That's when we need help, and that's where God comes in. His Word is like the salt in our experiment—providing direction and wisdom when we're unsure. We can always trust His Word to guide us.

Let your child add salt to the water slowly. The more salt is added, the higher the egg rises. In the same way, the more we seek God and follow His guidance, the more we choose to live in a way that honors Him and shows love to others, no matter the circumstances.

To wrap up, pray together, asking God to help you all remember to turn to Him and His Word to make wise and godly choices.
